Dyson Fraternity and Sorority Scholarship Award Nomination and Awarding Process

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| <i>April 1</i> | Self-nominations due to the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Affairs. |
| <i>April 15</i> | Deadline for student submission of financial information to the Office of Financial Aid. |
| <i>April 15</i> | The Office of Fraternity and Sorority Affairs will notify alumni contacts the nominations submitted by their respective chapter along with an additional list of chapter members. |
| <i>May 1</i> | Alumni return ranked chapter lists to Patty Case (pac25@cornell.edu). This information may be sent electronically. |
| <i>May-June</i> | The Office of Fraternity and Sorority Affairs sends the Office of Financial Aid the list of candidates for consideration. |
| <i>June</i> | Office of Financial Aid begins making awards by rank order of nominations, looking for individuals who meet eligibility requirements, having both grant and self-help components in their financial aid package. If none of the nominees qualify, the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Affairs will send a list of the remaining chapter members to alumni contacts. The alumni corporation will then rank this list in preference order and return to the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Affairs. |
| <i>July 1</i> | Office of Financial Aid begins the process of notifying recipients with standard financial aid award letters. (This letter does not explain the components of the award.) It is possible that some students may get a revision letter with additional information later. |
| <i>July 15</i> | The Office of Stewardship begins sending congratulatory letters from the Dean of Financial Aid to student recipients. These letters also seek biographic information to share with donors. |
| <i>July 15</i> | The Office of Fraternity and sorority Affairs begins notifying student recipients with copies to Corporation presidents and Dyson contacts. Students who self-nominated for an award, but were not chosen will also be notified. |
| <i>September</i> | Office of Stewardship begins sending basic student information and financial reports to Trustees, Councilors, and donors who have signed letter agreements or made significant commitments. The Office of Fraternity and Sorority Affairs notifies additional involved alumni and sends letters to non-recipients (except for Seal and Serpent). |
